Unfortunately, the access trail to the beach at Kalaloch Lodge was washed out by winter storms. Due to extensive damage there is no quick fix. Please be assured that we are working closely with the National Park Service to find a solution for this issue.

Please avoid this area; it is very unstable and not safe.

HOW DO YOU GET TO THE BEACH?

Kalaloch Campground

It is a short walk from the main lodge heading north towards Kalaloch Campground.

A path runs along the front of the lodge, crosses through our employee parking area, and then travels along Highway 101 for a short distance. A pedestrian bridge crosses Kalaloch Creek and then a nature trail enters the south end of the campground.

There are two beach access points on the south side of the campground - one near the group campsite and the other between sites A19 & A22. Both of these enter the beach north of Kalaloch Creek and are about a 10-minute walk from the main lodge.

Beach 2

To access the beach south of Kalaloch Creek, drive south along Highway 101 to Beach 2. This is about a mile south of the main lodge. There is vehicle parking at Beach 2 on both sides of the highway. The short beach access trail starts at the north end of the guardrail.
